

Recruitment of School of Archaeology and Museology

Peking University, Beijing, China in 2022

1. Department Overview

Peking University was the first to establish an archaeology teaching and research institution among all the universities in China. The School of Archaeology and Museology now includes the Department of Archaeology and the Department of Cultural Heritage, National Archaeological Experimental Teaching Center, National Virtual Simulation Experiment Center of Archaeology, and the Arthur. M. Sackler Museum of Art and Archaeology at Peking University.

The School consists of five undergraduate programs, which are Archaeology, Museum Studies, Conservation, Heritage Architecture, and Foreign Language and Foreign History (Archaeology). The Undergraduate Program of Archaeology was certificated as the National First-class Undergraduate Program in 2019 by Education Ministry of China. The School of Archaeology and Museology has a First-grade Discipline Doctoral Degree Conferring Unit in Archaeology and a Postdoctoral Research Center in Archaeology. It provides academic degrees in two categories: BA/Ph.D Degrees in Archaeology, and BA/MA Postgraduate Degrees in Museum Studies.

- Proficiency in at least one modern foreign language or ancient language besides English, be able to complete English language lessons and supervise undergraduate students' papers, be able to conduct two terms (64 hours) lecture program in World Archaeology independently;
- Have undertaken high-level research projects, and published high-level papers in core journals domestically or abroad;
- Applicants with a doctoral degree from an oversea university, or with rich experience in field archaeology oversea are preferred.

- iii. Be familiar with Buddhist grottoes and temples in China, and to have rich experience in the archaeological fieldworks of Buddhist sites and strong international communication ability;
- iv. Have undertaken high-level research projects, and published high-level papers in core journals domestically or abroad.

- iii. Have rich experience at archaeological science or conservation fields, with fieldwork archaeology experience as well;
- iv. Have undertaken high-level research projects, and published high-level papers in core journals domestically or abroad;

Position Description: teaching and research in **natural history museum study**

- iii. Have geology/biology professional training background, familiar with museum business, have certain exhibition practical experience and international communication ability, can be engaged in natural history and

 - v. Under the age of 40.

 - viii. Familiar with museum exhibition design, have fine arts or design background, able to undertake undergraduate and postgraduate courses from basic design to museum exhibition, and have strong international communication skills;
 - ix. Candidates who have high quality publish, or undertaken high-level research projects, or with rich exhibition design experiences are preferred;
 - x. Under the age of 40.

- a) Cover Letter, with the specific position and expected start time
 - b) Curriculum Vitae (CV), including the certificates of academic degrees and previous employments
 - c) Teaching proposal and research proposal
 - d) At least 3 references from experts in the field you apply, references from your supervisors or scholars you've cooperated before are also acceptable; if you apply for Tenured Associate Professor or Professor position, the School will have to arrange an external peer review refers to the requirements of tenure vacancy at Peking University. You can provide an advisory name list.
 - e) Additional material, including certificate of award, etc.

All the required documents above shall be sent before **30th April 2022** or second round by 1st Sept 2022 if first round recruitment is not filled.
